Another good entry of 3,265 prime lambs forward however meeting some resistance in trade to previous weeks although still returning a very satisfying overall average of 388ppkg, which would still be 30/40p ahead of this time last year. Export and Supermarket spec lambs sold well and all mainly trading between 380ppkg and 400ppkg. Heavy weight lambs similar with 48kg to 52kg lambs trading anywhere between £180 – £210. Lightweight lambs a relatively sharp trade and trading anywhere between 380ppkg and 400ppkg. More spring lambs are now required on a weekly basis to meet buyers' demand.

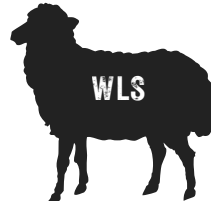
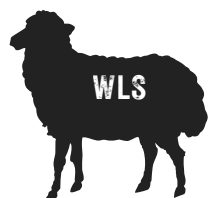

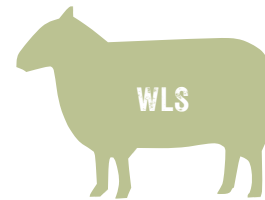
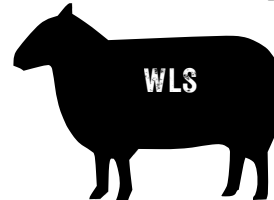
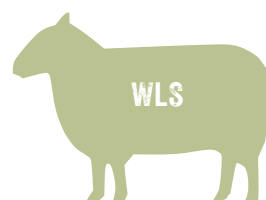
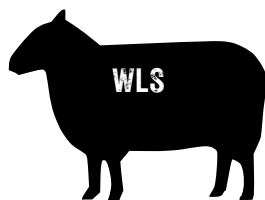
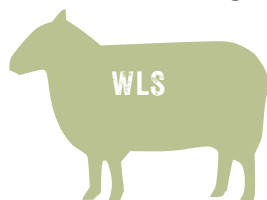
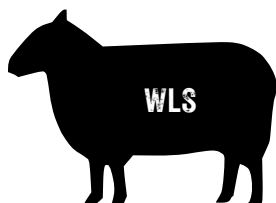
Similar number of cull ewes forward this week with a total of 2,214 penned and selling to an excellent trade from start to finish. The overall average returned at a very pleasing £166.24 per head which is unbelievable for time of year. A much stronger show of ewes forward on the week, however still several runs of hill ewes and half meat ewes present with buyers for all types. All crossbred ewes from £160 – £210 per head with quite a few very well-bred ewes and heavy ewes all over the £220 mark. Best Mules £170 – £190 per head with mediums Mules with meat mainly £130 – £160 per head. Leaner Mules anywhere from £110 – £125 per head. Strong Cheviots ewes £165 – £185 per head, strong Welsh ewes anywhere from £130 – £150 per head depending on size and cover, with medium Welsh all around that £90 – £120 per head and the smaller meat Welsh £55 – £90, with only a small handful of very small and lean ewes below £50 per head.

The ewes topped at £305 for a very well-bred Texel ewes presented by Red House Farm, Aberhafesp. Cull ram trade similar to last week's trade with rams selling to the highs of £255 for rams presented by Red House Farm, Aberhafesp. Numerous crossbred rams £160 to £220 with hill rams anything from £100 to £140.

Younger cows sold to £1944 for a Welsh Black cow weighing 675kg selling for 288ppkg from TP Price, Shettingau.

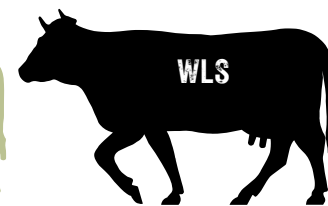
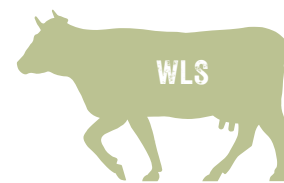
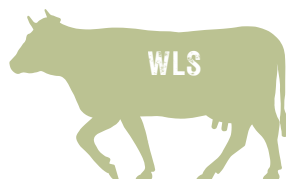
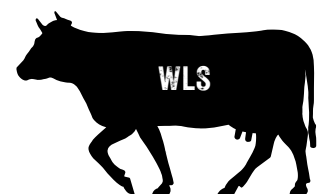

Welshpool remains the centre to sell your cows and calves with trade flying for the outfits on offer on Monday 29th June.

GI, JS & A Howells, Shadog Farm topped the trade at £7600 for a British Blue x Limousin 1st calver with a show potential Limousin x heifer calf at foot. A Limousin x British Blue 1st calver with a Limousin x bull calf sold at £7200. With other outfits at £6300 and £6000, the 10 forward from Shadog averaged £5620.

A cracking entry of 7 Pedigree Limousin cows with Limousin calves at foot sold to a top of £5550 for a 1st calver, with a heifer calf. Following it closely was a similar outfit at £5500. With other outfits at £5350 and £5000, and the 7 averaged £4893.

A Limousin x 1st calver with a Charolais bull calf from JP Breeze & Son, Vronladies sold for £4850.

Presented by P Mason, New Haven was a Simmental x 1st calver with a Charolais x bull calf which sold for £4150.

From CE Owen, Garth Vaughan were 5 British Blue x 1st calvers with Limousin calves at foot which sold from £3300 to a top of £4000 to average £3800.

Two Pedigree Charolais bulls, born March 2025 from JA Williams, Llechwedd Ddrys sold for £4000 apiece.
