Top price – 401ppkg or £209.50

Averages 345.28ppkg or £149.88

Another good entry of 4,079 prime lambs forward meeting a harder trade on the week and retuning an overall average of 346ppk. Export and Supermarket spec lambs sold well and all mainly trading between 345ppkg and 360ppkg, with the best confirmation lambs all north of 370ppkg. Heavy weight lambs similar with 48kg to 52kg lambs trading anywhere between £165 – £185. Lightweight lambs also harder work and trading generally between 325ppkg and 345ppkg. Similar number of spring lambs are now required on a weekly basis to meet buyers' demand.

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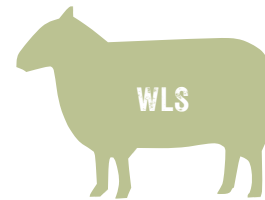
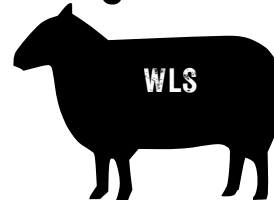
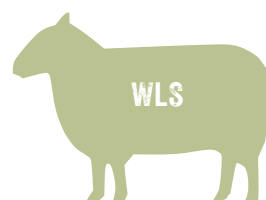
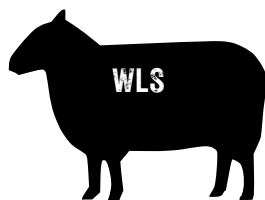
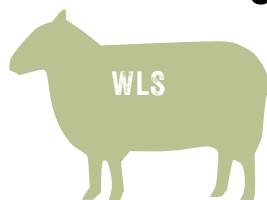
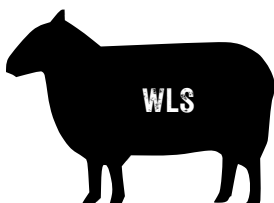
Strong number of cull ewes forward yet again this week with a total of 2,327 penned and selling to an excellent trade from start to finish. The overall average returned at a very pleasing £135.68 per head with trade definitely sharper on the week. The entry included several runs of stronger crossbred ewes however as usual several runs of hill ewes and half meat ewes also present with buyers for all types. All crossbred ewes from £150 - £190 per head with quite a few very well-bred ewes and heavy ewes all over the £200 mark. Best Mules £170 - £190 per head with mediums Mules with meat mainly £130 - £160 per head.

Leaner Mules anywhere from £110 - £125 per head. Strong Cheviots ewes £165 - £185 per head, strong Welsh ewes anywhere from £130 - £150 per head depending on size and cover, with medium Welsh all around that £90 - £120 per head and the smaller meat Welsh £55 - £90, with only a small handful of very small and lean ewes below £50 per head.

The ewes topped at £257 for a pen of 3 very well-bred Texel ewes presented by CE Pryce, Yr Helyg. Cull ram trade similar to last week's trade with rams selling to the highs of £242 for rams presented by DM & RC Rees, Dugwm Farm. Numerous crossbred rams £160 to £220 with hill rams anything from £100 to £140. Ewes will be wanted again next week please. 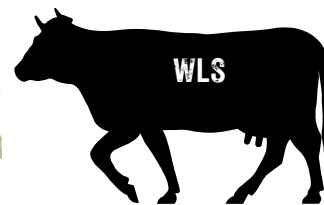
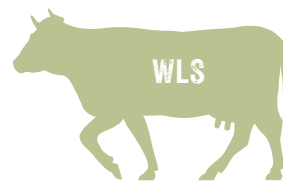
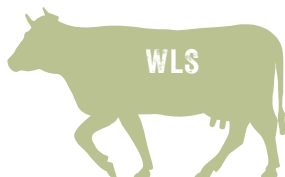
Cows 48 to 72 months topped at £2543.07 (309ppkg) for a 823kg Charolais from RA Owen, Llwyn Y Gog.

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A respectable entry of store lambs forward this week, with trade holding much the same as last week. Compared to the falling prime lamb trade, store lambs are looking the dearer option.

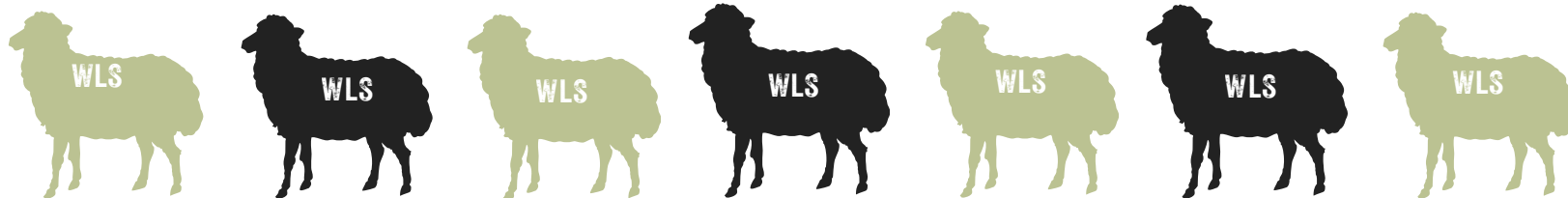
The stronger, bigger-framed lambs were the easiest sold, with several pens making over £130/head, as buyers continue to look for lambs that will finish quickly. Smaller, longer-term lambs remain harder to shift, with the dry weather continuing to affect grass supplies and buyer confidence. Those lambs are taking a bit more selling, with purchasers being much more selective.

Cows & Calves (11)

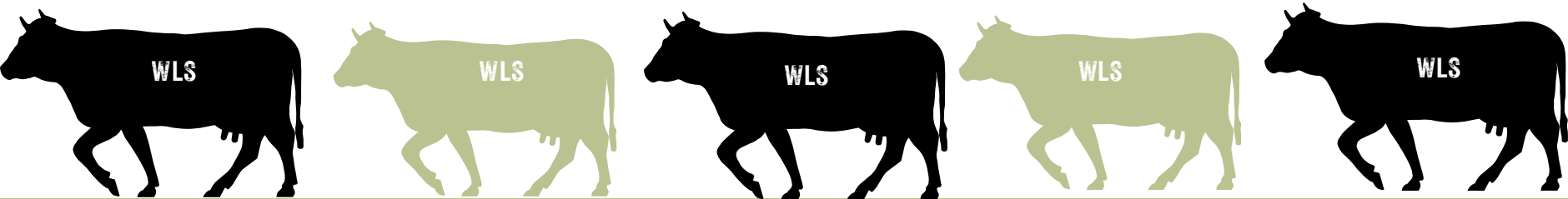
