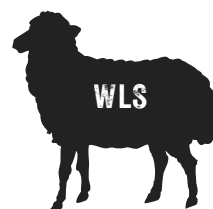
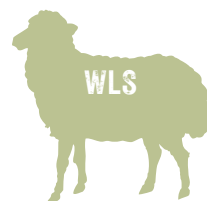
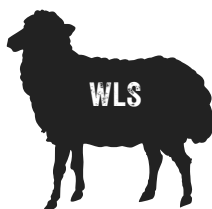
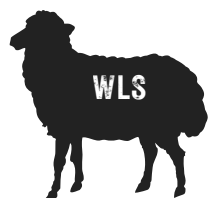
Another good entry of 4,192 prime lambs forward meeting a welcomed lift in the trade and retuning an overall average of 332ppk. Export and Supermarket spec lambs sold well and all mainly trading between 330ppkg and 340ppkg, with the best confirmation lambs all north of 350ppkg. Heavy weight lambs similar with 48kg to 55kg lambs trading anywhere between £154 – £180. Lightweight lambs very sharp on the week and trading generally between 330ppkg and 350ppkg. Similar number of spring lambs are now required on a weekly basis to meet buyers' demand.

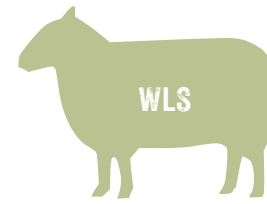
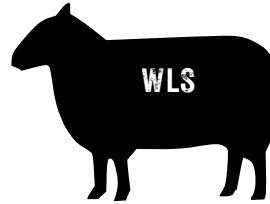
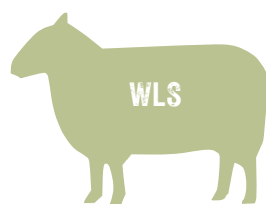
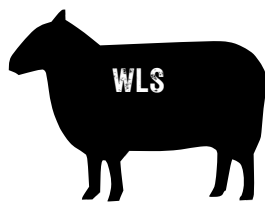
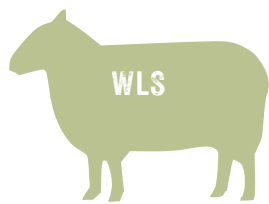
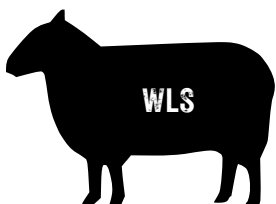
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Strong numbers of cull ewes forward yet again this week with a total of 3,051 penned and selling to an excellent trade from start to finish. The overall average returned at a very pleasing £123.02 per head with trade identical on the week. The entry included several runs of stronger crossbred ewes however as usual several runs of hill ewes and half meat ewes also present with buyers for all types and helped by the presence of a couple of grazing and feeding men. All crossbred ewes from £150 – £190 per head with quite a few very well-bred ewes and heavy ewes all over the £200 mark. Best Mules £160 – £190 per head with mediums Mules with meat mainly £130 – £150 per head. Leaner Mules anywhere from £100 – £120 per head. Strong Cheviots ewes £145 – £160 per head, strong Welsh ewes anywhere from £110 – £130 per head depending on size and cover, with medium Welsh all around that £70 – £90 per head and the smaller meated Welsh £35 – £60, with only a small handful of very small and lean ewes below £30 per head. The ewes topped at £294 for a Texel ewe presented by S Lewis, Trefaes Fawr. Cull ram trade similar to last week's trade with rams selling to the highs of £260 for rams presented by E Jones, Ty Isaf. Numerous crossbred rams £160 to £220 with hill rams anything from £100 to £140.
