A smaller entry of 3308 hoggs forward meeting another sharp trade on the week, with all weights seeing spirited bidding and strong demand. The overall average returned at 359ppkg. Export and Supermarket spec hoggs mainly trading between 345ppkg and 365ppkg. Best hoggs trading 370ppkg to 400ppkg. Heavy weight hoggs very much in demand this week with 50kg to 54kg lambs trading anywhere between £155 - £180. Lightweight hogg also similar on the week and mainly trading anywhere between 320ppkg and 340ppkg depending on breed and meat cover. Good number of prime hoggs will be required next week please! Due to increasing pressure from Abattoirs and the Meat Hygiene Service, it is now strongly advisable that in order to market your sheep to their maximum potential that all hoggs big or small and whether from inside or outside be BELLY CLIPPED before arrival at market

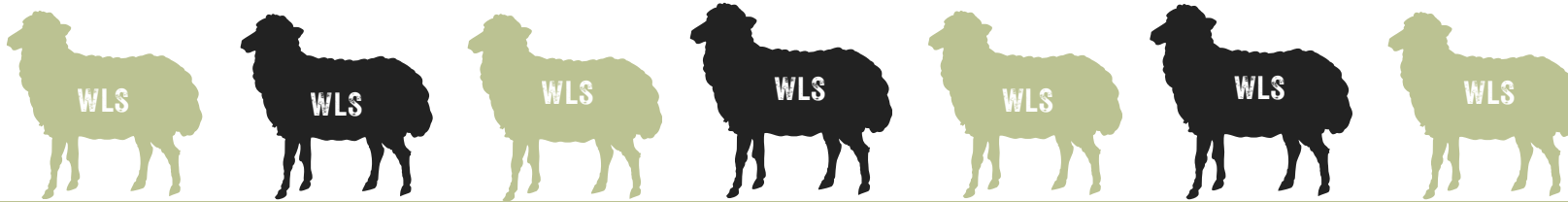

Younger cows sold to 344ppkg for a Limousin x cow weighing 745kg making £2562.80 from G Jones & Partners, Maenllwyd. Next at £2104.50 was a Simmental x cow weighing 690kg selling for 305ppkg from RI & G Davies, Penlanllwyd. Heifers under 48 months topped the day at £3314.52 for a Limousin x heifer weighing 837kg which sold for 396ppkg from DI Roberts & Son, Stingwern. Selling for 408ppkg was a British Blue x heifer weighing 605kg making £2468.40 from Bowen & Bowen, Penthrryn.

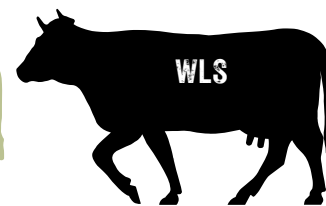
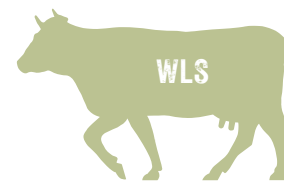
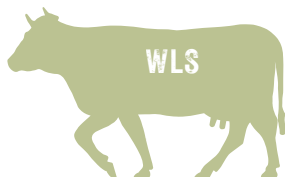
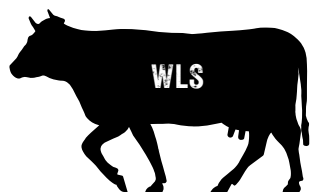

Large numbers forward again this week with a total of 2,696 cull ewes forward selling to a slower and harder trade as was seen in other centres nationally at the end of last week. Generally, all types of ewes would be back £10 - £20 per head on the week, affected by the beginning or Ramadan and fasting one could only assume. All crossbred ewes from £140 - £180 per head with anything very well-bred or heavy all over the £200 mark. Best Mules £130 - £160 per head with mediums Mules with meat mainly £110 - £125 per head. Leaner Mules anywhere from £85 - £105 per head. Strong hill ewes £100 - £125 per head depending on size and cover, with medium Welsh all around that £75 - £98 per head and the smaller meated Welsh £40 - £70, with very few ewes below £30 per head.

The ewes topped at £296 for a Texel ewe presented by J Ruggeri, Gwaelod Y Rhos. Cull ram trade similar to last week's trade with very few best rams forward however rams' selling to highs of £230 for a ram presented by TE Rowlands Ai Fab, Tyddyn Du. Numerous crossbred rams £140 to £180 with hill rams anything from £90 to £140.

A strong entry of store hogs forward again this week as we move closer towards spring, with numbers remaining ahead of expectations for the time of year. The strongest and best-bred sorts met another firm trade, with buyers showing keen interest in well-fleshed hogs capable of finishing in the near term.

Longer-term hogs proved more difficult to place, with the continued wet weather and associated keep costs tempering demand for plainer and hill-bred types. Nevertheless, all classes cleared, with trade overall remaining respectable considering the challenging conditions underfoot.

Mixed and clean lambs average £101.67 and to £131 from SM & GD Jones, Rhiwhiriaeth

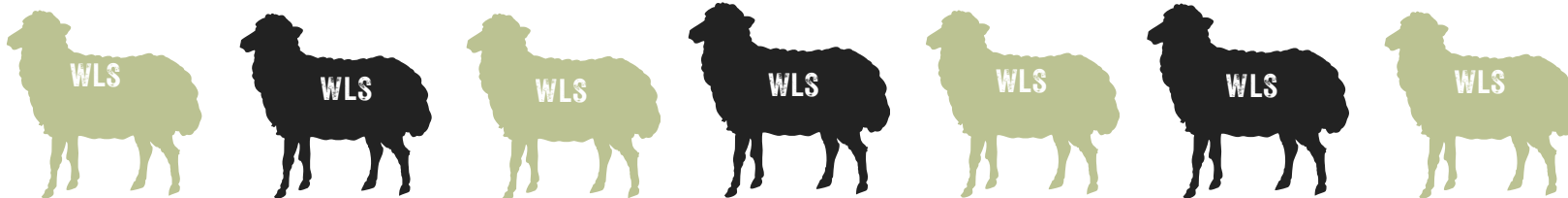

Only 250 in-lamb ewes forward, with entries generally coming from ongoing dispersal/reduction sales, with the sheep on offer being hardier, hill bred types. Trade on the whole similar to last week, with the wet weather perhaps again putting people off.

AM Jones sells flock ages North Country Mule ewes in lamb to Charollais rams at 175% to £220. Bettws Hall Farms sells 42 full mouth and as found Highlander ewes in lamb to Sufftex rams at 205% to £215 and averaged £198.33

DT & CE Jones sells 22 Texel and Mule flock aged ewes in lamb to Texel rams at 119% to £200 and average £176.74.

DI & RE Lewis sells 32 mule yearling to 3yo ewes in lamb to Texel at 100% to £180 and average £158.43 and 45 flock ages Welsh ewes in lamb to BFL x Texel at £100 for £85.

PR Williams sells 50 Welsh full mouth ewes in lamb to Texel or Dutch Spotted rams at 200% for £140.

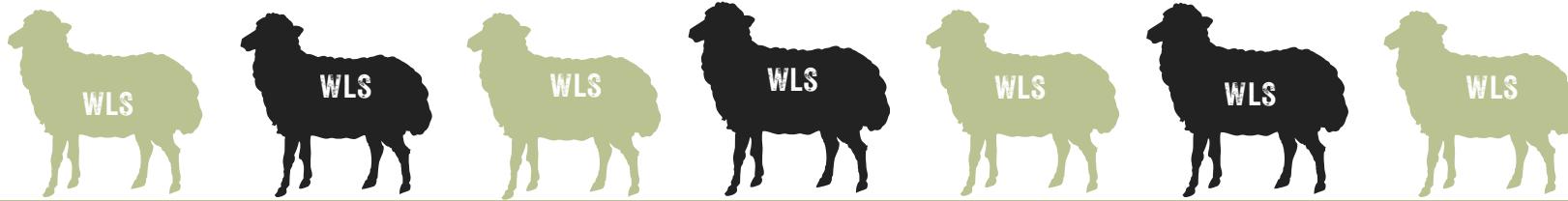

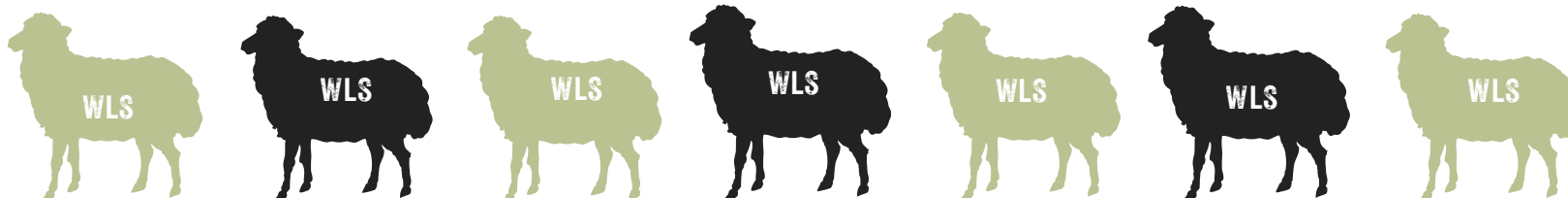
